To Whom It May Concern:

I am writing this in regards to my experiences with Cematrix Cellular Concrete. Though I had heard good things about Cematrix, this was the first project I was involved with that where it was used.

Our project had lots of underground spools, concrete lines, and manholes, making backfill a challenge. With hundreds of foundations and pedestals scattered around the site, just getting the equipment into the areas to work was difficult.

Cematrix as a substitute to backfill was a good choice for this project because it simplified the installation of the material (i.e. backfill) required under the paving. It not only eliminated the need for backfill, but geotextiles, Styrofoam and ¾" crush were also no longer necessary. Using Cematrix as a replacement for all these different materials saved time and money on the project. Another advantage of using Cematrix is that the day after it was poured, we were able to continue with forming and other work in the area.

Not only can you use it as a working surface the day after it is poured, Cematrix saves on equipment, labour, and material (backfill) costs. Now that this current project is 95% complete with Cematrix, I know I would absolutely use this product on any future project I am involved with.
